In-bed systems for complex needs

Use Immedia SatinSheet and 4WayGlide in-bed systems in combination with LeanOnMe positioning cushions to demonstrate positioning and turning techniques that promote good working posture and can help reduce anxiety and maximise comfort for users with complex needs.



Hoists and slings - managing function, safety and comfort
